Esoterics in the Craft

We have all heard the word “Esoterics” in Masonry and if you have not, you undoubtedly will and some point during your masonic career. But, what exactly does the word “Esoteric” mean? Well, by definition, it means only to be understood by a small number of people with a specialized knowledge or interest. We use Esoteric work in our rituals as by it’s very definition some of our symbols and parts of the ritual we have are only to be understood by those who have gone through the ceremonies of the degrees. As opposed to the Exoteric work in the Craft which means you need not have gone through the ceremonies in order to understand the meanings behind what is presented. So as a prime example of one of our symbols that is esoteric in nature and known to most everyone as the emblem of Freemasonry, the square and compass with the letter G in the middle. We learn in the Entered Apprentice Degree the meaning behind the various forms, supports, ornaments and lights of the lodge, of which the square and compass are a very important part of what is explained. And for the letter G, we learn in the Fellowcraft degree an important lecture about it’s meaning and history to us as a craft. This is just one example of the esoteric work in the craft. There are many more examples throughout the first three degrees and the different rites of Masonry.
