The Master of the lodge that year was an Irish immigrant that came to the United States through Ellis Island at the age of 24 in August of 1910. He listed his occupation as a carpenter and his destination was Arizona. Upon arriving in Mesa, it did not take long for him to put his trade talent into practice.

By the start of 1920, he was well known for his skilled craftsmanship. He built many notable homes for prominent figures in Mesa. He also built commercial and public buildings such as the old Mesa City Hall. His work is identified as that of a Master Builder.

The correlation of his life's journey and the life of a Mason seems to fit like a glove. In a profound way, it seems he fit directly into the essence of what Freemasonry is. Beginning a life anew in a foreign land, honing his God given talents, becoming well respected in his trade, and serving his fellow man by becoming a Master Builder.

As we begin this new year, I am humbled by the greatness of the men that have served this lodge and grateful to them. Just like our 1923 Past Master, **Joseph A. Nesbitt**, all the Master Builders who have come before us, have built a strong foundation for us to be proud of and to continue to build on as members of Oriental 20.
